The MGAA Swim Team depends on 100% parent involvement for successful swim meets. It takes over 60 parents to run a home swim meet and over 40 to run an away meet! Many hands make light work.

Meets are scheduled on the following dates.

June: 6th (H), 13th (H), 20th (A) and 27th (H)

July: 5th (A) and 11th (H)

NOTE: All meets will be Tuesday evenings with the exception of the 7/5 meet, which is a Wednesday.

Parents of any Sea Dragons swimmer(s) **MUST** sign up to work three (3) meet halves. By registering your swimmer on the Magnolia Green Swim Team, you are agreeing to work a minimum of three (3) meet halves. Volunteering is a **REQUIREMENT** in order for your child to participate with the swim team regardless of whether they swim in the meets. However, if you are unable to volunteer at swim meets, please contact us and we may be able to offer volunteer positions outside of meet nights. Some positions require easy training and attendance at a training session, which counts as working a meet half. Please volunteer early to ensure you get the spots you want and record your commitments. Our Volunteer Coordinator, Kelly Sarver, will be communicating with you to confirm meet times and positions. As we get closer to the start of the swim season, we will have a schedule of trainings available for positions like Strokes and Turns.

At the beginning of each meet, you will need to sign in at the volunteer table and obtain a name tag. If you cannot work the session you volunteered for, then you must find a replacement for your position. If you are a no-show for your assigned volunteer position or do not commit to the required number of meet halves, the MGAA reserves the right to assess a **\$150 fee per half unfulfilled**. Fees for missed volunteer hours will be **automatically charged to the card on file August 1, 2023**. In addition, multiple no-shows can put your swimmer's participation in practice and meets as well as their eligibility for Champs at risk. MGAA also reserves the right to assign you to unfilled volunteer positions if you have not met your volunteer requirement. You are ultimately responsible for finding a replacement and communicating any changes to the team's Volunteer Coordinator if you are unable to volunteer at a meet.

If you are a parent of ONLY a Mini Sea Dragon swimmer, you are not required to volunteer at regular team swim meets. There are other volunteer commitments for the Mini Dragons program.
